Bond International College International Student Agreement

International student, regardless of age, must abide by the following conditions as stated by Bond International College (BIC/the School):

- 1. The student must comply with the laws of Canada, the Province of Ontario and the City of Toronto.
- 2. The student must follow all the school rules, policies, regulations, and Code of Behaviors regarding attendance, course responsibilities and behavior.
- 3. BIC has the right to make educational decisions, including placement and program selections, in the best interests of the student within available resources.
- 4. The student or custodian must notify BIC in writing if the student moves or changes custodian.
- 5. The student must attend all classes unless unable due to illness or injury and must provide a note from a parent, custodian, or homestay family for any absences.
- 6. The student must maintain a full timetable and may not withdraw from courses without consent of both school officials and their parent/custodian.
- 7. The student may not take credit courses outside BIC unless the course is not offered by the School **and** has been approved by the Principal.
- 8. It is the student's responsibility to maintain a current Study Permit from Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada.
- 9. The student is required to enroll in medical insurance for the entire duration of his/her program at BIC. It is the student's responsibility to maintain adequate medical insurance and BIC is not responsible for any loss or damage suffered by the student if the student cancels or fails to extend his/her insurance when required.
- 10. The student and his/her parent(s) understand and agree that the tuition and fees (including accommodation fees, if any) paid are refundable if the student's application for a Study Permit is rejected by the Canadian Immigration authorities. The deadline for submitting the refund application is within 6 months from the issuance of the rejection letter. If a student voluntarily withdraws or is removed from BIC, any unused prepaid tuition and fees will NOT be refunded. Please refer to the agreement for further refund policy regarding pathway programs.



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- 11. For student living at Homestay with BIC being the student's custodian, the custodianship terminates immediately and automatically if any of the following incidents occurs.
 - a) The student voluntarily moves out of Homestay and/or withdraws from BIC.
 - b) The student is removed/expelled from BIC (including homestay) due to serious violations of BIC School Code of Behaviors and/or other BIC rules & regulations.
 - c) If the student is detained and/or arrested by the police, the school will continue its custodian obligations until the student's parent(s) or other parental representative(s) arrives.
 - d) Other behaviors of the student that are deemed unacceptable and inappropriate to BIC.
- 12. BIC has the right to remove the student without refund of the tuition and fees if any of the following incidents occurs:
 - a) The student is in violation of the laws of Canada, the Province of Ontario and the City of Toronto.
 - b) The student is in serious violation of the BIC School Code of Behavior or other school regulations.
 - c) The student submits false information on the school or study permit application.
